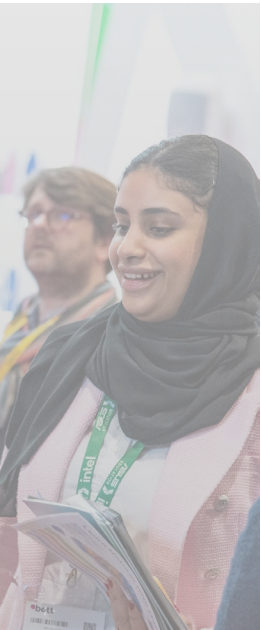

Our innovation team collaborate with amazing educators and experts to innovate resources that revolutionise teaching and learning.

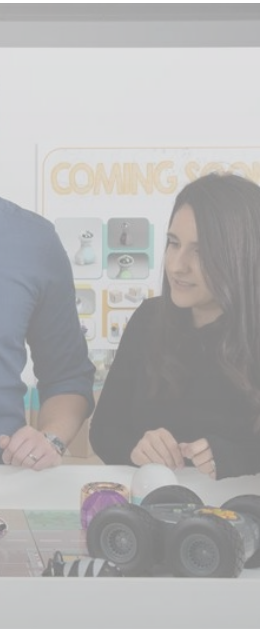
2. Design & Prototype

Glow, Sensory and Wellbeing
